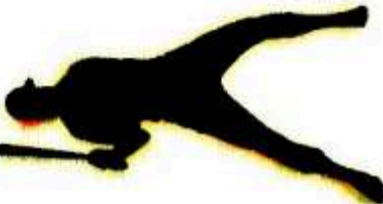


# Living Springs Camp

## Registration

Attendance at Living Springs Camp is \$75 per week. This charge covers food and supplies for each child. To ensure your place at camp, please fill out and send in the registration form with \$15.00 one week prior to the date of your camp. \$10.00 of this fee will be applied to the camper's Canteen account upon arrival and \$5.00 will purchase a Living Springs Camp T-Shirt. **This is a non-refundable deposit.** Any camper not completely registered (Registration form, Registration fee paid, and Medical Release Form) on the **Monday** before the week of camp you plan to attend cannot be guaranteed a bed. You will be processed on a first come basis according to availability of beds.



## Sponsors

A minimum of one adult man and one adult lady is preferred for each group. One adult for every ten campers thereafter. Any sponsors above those required pay the camper fee.

## Dress Code

Living Springs Camp is a Christian camp and requires its guests to honor the Lord in appearance and conduct. We reserve the right to request a change in any clothing or behavior deemed inappropriate. Wholesome standards displaying **modesty and distinction** between the sexes are intended to be a help and blessing to you.

### Girls:

Girls will wear skirts, dresses, or culottes that reach to the bottom of the knee. No sleeveless tops, dresses, or crop tops please. Dresses or skirts are to be worn to the evening services. We ask that girls bring a modest, one-piece swimsuit.

### Boys:

Boys will need to wear long pants. For the evening services, boys will wear a collared shirt and jeans or khakis. Do not bring tank tops or shorts. (Can wear shorts during swimming time only.) Boys will not be allowed to wear earrings, necklaces or bracelets.

### Everyone:

T-shirts worn by boys or girls may not show profanity or support movies, alcohol, or videos, etc. Please, help us by abiding by the dress code.



## Directions to Living Springs Camp from Festus:

Take I-55 south to Hwy 61 S. (exit 170). Go south on Hwy. 61 S. approximately 4 1/2 miles to Danby Rd. Turn right on Danby Rd. Stay on Danby Rd. until it intersects with TT Hwy. Turn right on TT Hwy., then turn left at the second drive on the left. Proceed one mile on grave road (following signs) to Living Springs Camp.
